

Purpose

The Grandfathering Guidelines for the IAISP (International Association of Information Security Professionals) Certification Launch Offer are designed to provide a pathway for experienced professionals to obtain IAISP's Gold Standard CAISE (Certified Artificial Intelligence Expert) certification based on their existing expertise and contributions in the field of designing, implementing, and managing secure AI systems/ Cyber Security.



Eligibility Criteria

To qualify for CAISE Certification by the IAISP, candidates must meet the following eligibility criteria:

Experience:

Minimum of **5 years** of professional experience in AI security, including experience in designing, implementing, and managing secure AI systems.

Education:

A bachelor's degree in computer science, information technology, artificial intelligence, machine learning, cybersecurity, or a related discipline can provide a **one-year** waiver in the experience.

A Masters' degree in computer science, information technology, artificial intelligence, machine learning, cybersecurity, or a related discipline can provide a **two-year** waiver in the experience requirement.

Training / Certification Holder:

Holders of CISA, CRISC, CISSP, CCSP, or CISM certificates can receive exemption from **one-year** of the experience requirement.

Professional References:

Submission of professional references from individuals who can attest to the candidate's expertise and experience in AI security.

Adherence to Code of Ethics:

Agreement to abide by the IAISP Code of Ethics, which outlines the ethical standards and principles expected of certified professionals.





Application Process:

- ▶ Complete the online CAISE Grandfathering Application Form available on our website at [IAISP.org](https://www.iaisp.org).
- ▶ Pay the designated CAISE Grandfathering Application.
- ▶ Upon submission, the IAISP certification board will review your application and supporting materials to determine eligibility for the CAISE Grandfathering pathway.

Assessment Criteria:

- ▶ The IAISP certification board will assess applicants based on their demonstrated knowledge, skills, and experience in key CAISE domains, including but not limited to cybersecurity & AI, Security Operations, compliance, incident response, and governance.
- ▶ Evaluation may include a review of submitted projects, publications, certifications, training records, contributions to the information security community, and other evidence of information security expertise and impact.
- ▶ Applicants may be required to undergo additional assessments, interviews, or examinations as part of the Grandfathering process to validate their information security knowledge and skills.

Certification Award: Upon successful review and verification of eligibility, candidates approved through the Grandfathering pathway will be awarded the IAISP's Gold Standard CAISE certification.

- **Certification validity period:** 3 years
- **Recertification requirements:** Grandfathered IAISP's CAISE certification holders will need to meet ongoing recertification requirements, such as continuing education, professional development activities, or maintaining active involvement in the information security field, and paying an annual maintenance fee for the certification.
